ADMISSION PROCEDURE | ENROLMENT

I. Admission WITH an entrance exam

HOW?

Admission via e-mail

If you want to enrol after passing the entrance exam successfully, please contact our Registrar's Office within the regular admission period (see below) via e-mail: studienabteilung@kug.ac.at

Enrolment in person can be carried out ONLY if necessary and ONLY upon prior appointment in <u>Registrar's</u> <u>Office</u> (Palais Meran, Leonhardstraße 15, 8010 Graz, ground floor, room 16). In this case, please write an e-mail to: <u>studienabteilung@kug.ac.at</u>

PLEASE NOTE: Your documents have to be submitted only when they are complete! Incomplete or missing documents cannot be processed.

WHEN?

Regular admission period: 30 August 2023 – 28 September 2023

II. Admission WITHOUT an entrance exam

(Musicology, Incoming-Students or Concurrently Enrolled Students)

HOW?

Step 1: Online application

First of all, you have to **register** <u>online</u> on your own on: <u>online.kug.ac.at</u> (for help see <u>video instruction</u>).

Step 2: Admission via e-mail

Only after the completed online application, you can carry out the actual enrolment via e-mail: studienabteilung@kug.ac.at

Short instruction for the online application

- 1. Go to KUGonline: <u>online.kug.ac.at</u> 2. Click on the link "Create applicant account", fill in :

- 3. Log in with your user data

- 5. Fill out the forms and send the online application



Admission period for <u>Musicology</u>: 10 July 2023 – 31 October 2023 Regular admission period: 30 August 2023 – 28 September 2023

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The following copies of documents are required for the admission:



In the course of the admission, you will receive a **payment form,** in order to pay the <u>ÖH student union fee and/or</u> <u>tuition fee</u>. As soon as you have paid these fees (be aware, that it may take 3 to 10 days before the sum is transferred from your bank to the KUG) you will automatically receive an email to your private e-mail address and afterwards you can <u>register</u> for your courses via KUGonline.¹

PLEASE MIND: Registration for courses via KUGonline is only possible until <u>3 March 2023</u>!

PLEASE NOTE: Even if you have made the initial approval, you will have to report the continuation of your studies for each further semester by paying the ÖH student union fee and, if applicable, the tuition fee (via KUGonline)!

STUDENT ID / KUGcard

On the occasion of the initial approval at KUG, the KUGcard will be issued by the Registrar's Office (or by the Institute Oberschützen) during the admission procedure. In order to receive your <u>KUGcard</u> (only possible, if you have already <u>uploaded</u> a photo via KUGonline in the course of your online application), please contact the Registrar's Office via e-mail: <u>studienabteilung@kug.ac.at</u>

International Students from EU/EEA countries and Switzerland have to apply for an <u>EU-registration certificate</u> ("Anmeldebescheinigung") within 4 months after their entry to Austria, <u>in addition</u> to their registration of residence ("Meldezettel"). Information and <u>application forms</u> are also available on our website.

¹ KUGonline was implemented to serve course registration and the whole examination system at the KUG. **This means that** registering for courses, in addition to the personal discussion with your teachers, must be carried out also via this programme without exception! <u>Without registering via KUGonline, you will not be able to receive a transcript!</u>

International Students from Non-EU/EEA Countries will receive a confirmation that they have passed the entrance exam via email from the Registrar's Office (on request only: admission@kug.ac.at). This confirmation will be required for the residence permit!

Social Health Insurance for Students ("ÖGK" etc.)

For information about social health insurance see below \rightarrow <u>https://www.kug.ac.at/en/versicherung/</u>

- If you are insured e.g. under your parents' plan, you do not have to worry about insurance. This applies to students from Austria and students from other EU-countries with an European insurance card, if this is also valid in Austria.
- Otherwise, please contact the ÖGK by phone or email. You can also make an appointment in advance by phone or online, if you think you should discuss this in person:

- The current (status 2023) monthly fee is € 66.79 ("Self-insurance for students")
- This fee must be paid regularly, otherwise the insurance will be cancelled! Continuing the insurance later comes at a very high cost (about € 200 monthly)!
- <u>Students from Non-EU/EEA countries</u> please mind: Without insurance, you will not be able to receive a residence permit for Austria!
- Self-insurance for students is possible for all degree programme students as well as for non-degree programme students taking preparatory courses at KUG (regardless of nationality).
- Students who are taking a <u>university course</u> (e.g. Elementary Music Education, postgraduate university courses) are not entitled to the self-insurance for students at the ÖGK! Furthermore, <u>for students from non-EU/EEA countries</u>, who are <u>taking university courses</u> and who have no prior insurance periods within the EU/EEA, the available insurance will therefore cost a lot in the first 6 months. You must register for private health insurance <u>immediately after arriving</u> in Austria and, <u>in addition</u>, pay into the official insurance company (incl. waiting period)!!
- Possible pre-insurance periods in an EU member state must be demonstrated with the respective form. This
 proof is issued by health insurers in the respective EU/EEA member state (pre-insurance periods: 6 weeks
 before the application or in the last 12 months through 26 weeks then no waiting period, where
 applicable).

Please mind: Basically, it is not ensured, whether you can receive a residence permit student for university courses!!!

- If you have questions concerning <u>alternative insurance options</u> for Non-EU/EEA students (which are also recognized for the residence permit), please contact the Welcome Center **in time**!

>>> HINT: An alternative option e.g. is provided by FeelSafe.

Public Transport

If you want to order a <u>student pass</u> for traveling by public transport between the place of residence and the institution of studying your application form have to be confirmed on request at the Registrar's Office (prerequisite: degree programme student; please also mind the age limit). For those particularly keen to travel there are another two options: a nationwide <u>KlimaTicket Österreich</u> and <u>KlimaTicket Steiermark</u> (whole State of Styria)

You will get your student pass (e.g. "Top Ticket for students") or KlimaTicket at the Mobility and Sales Center ("Mobilitäts- und Vertriebscenter"), Jakoministraße 1, 8010 Graz or online in the Graz Linien <u>ticket shop</u>.

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WHOSE MOTHER TONGUE IS NOT GERMAN

In order to be able to study at the KUG, a **specific level of German² language competency**, depending on the chosen degree programme **is expected** from applicants whose mother tongue is not the language of instruction of the chosen degree programme. Therefore, you will have to submit a **proof of your German language competency** on the one hand already **at the time of application/admission** to the study programme, and on the other hand <u>at the latest</u> **until a determinate deadline**, which is specified in the respective curriculum.* <u>Here</u> you can find further information about the required German language competency at the KUG.

* Please mind: If you do not submit a proof of the required German language competency in time, you will not be able to be admitted or to continue your regular studies!!!

German course / German test

For students of KUG a German course has been offered by the **University Preparation Programme** (Vorstudienlehrgang / "VGUH") ein eigener Deutschkurs eingerichtet.

- PLEASE MIND: Please register online on public.vguh.at

² If curriculum of a study programme specifies English as the language of instruction or if the knowledge of English language is defined as a prerequisite for admission, the following regulations refer to the English language (see decree of the Rectorate of KUG as at 9 January 2019 – German only!).

- You have to take a **mandatory placement test** for the winter term. For further information please consult the website of the VGUH: <u>https://vorstudienlehrgang.at/en/graz/course-registration/</u>
- The **German language course fee** for the summer term for regular students <u>can be found on the website of</u> <u>the VGUH!</u>

ATTENTION: To students, who attend the VGUH course in advance in preparation for their regular studies (applies to: Musicology, Electrical Engineering - Audio Engineering), apply other tariffs and semester hours (see homepage of the VGUH)!

The fee for the test is $\mathbf{\in 40}$ and must be paid until the respective date mentioned on the website.
